





Funded Pharmacy Undergraduate Placement Programme (FPUPP)

The education and training of undergraduate student pharmacists has changed. Could you help to secure a new generation of competent, confident pharmacists?

FPUPP training sites must provide:

- A Placement Supervisor: a registered health care professional who holds relevant clinical skills and knowledge of the training requirements for pharmacists
- Opportunities for students to engage in interprofessional experiential learning and clinical activities
- A supportive learning environment, where students will be treated with dignity and respect
- Placements consisting of a 5-day block (37.5 hours, Monday to Friday)
- Feedback and evaluation of the programme
- A commitment to HEIW's quality management framework
